#### What is Make Your Mark?

The Make Your Mark ballot happens yearly. People aged 11-18 have the chance to take part in this special voting system specifically designed for young people. This can be done through various options which include filling in a ballot paper and filling in a tally sheet. There are 3 votes available to choose which include the topics: a UK issue, a devolved issue and a local issue. The deadline is 8<sup>th</sup> October 2019 and Goldington Academy students have been invited to vote alongside other schools.

#### What is the Youth Parliament?

The UK Youth Parliament (UKYP) come together to debate and decide the most important issues that young people strongly believe in. The UKYP is made up of young people from years 6 up to 18 years old. They provide opportunities for young people to have their say in order to bring action and influence decision makers. The UKYP is made up of 300 members nationally who are elected via youth elections which take place throughout the UK. They help administer and plan Make Your Mark so that young people are able to vote in a variety of different ways.
