Dear Parent/Carer

Further to Mrs Ross' letter of 8 June I write with a few additional pieces of information with regard to your child returning to school from Monday 15 June. All other aspects of the letter remain the same.

- Please note that if your child, or any member of your family, is feeling at all unwell they should not attend school under any circumstances.
- If possible, we would prefer it if your child did not bring a bike to school, although we appreciate for a few children having to travel some distance they will need to do this and we will make provision for them.
- In accordance with government guidelines we will not be allowing children to wear any form of gloves in school. We request that they do not wear or bring any. Hand sanitizer is provided in every classroom.
- Please ask your child to bring in any work (for any subject) that they would like assessed or marked. We will collect this and ensure that, after suitable hygiene controls have been implemented, it gets to the correct teacher for appropriate assessment. All work should be clearly marked with both the pupil's name and the name of the relevant teacher.
- We anticipate that the majority of pupils will bring a phone in to school with them. Although we will not be collecting these in, we will ask that all phones are switched off for the duration of the lesson and put out of sight.

We are really looking forward to seeing your child next week – please remind them to bring in all the equipment they will need (e.g. pens, pencils etc). We have worked very hard to ensure that school is a safe and secure environment for your child and that they will have lessons that complement the work we will continue to set for them to complete at home.
