The following contains details of the keyworker rooms for next week.

- a) The keyworker rooms for Year 7 & 8 students will be open up to and including the day of return. i.e. Year 7 (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) and Year 8 (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday).
- b) On the day of the return, you have the option of either sending them in as per their staggered return times or to the keyworker room at 8:30am from where they will be sent to their Covid tests.
- c) Please note that school uniform needs to be worn from Monday, 8th March 2021.
- d) On Monday 8th March 2021, year 7 students will have a PE lesson: please ensure that they arrive in their PE kit.
- e) On Wednesday, 10th March 2021, year 8 students will have a PE lesson: please ensure that they arrive in their PE kit.
- f) Please provide packed lunches for students for all days up to and including their day of return.
- g) Stationery will need to be brought in from Monday as students will be working in books/paper/worksheets.
