All students in Year 10 will have access to this excellent website, with younger years starting to use it in future months.

Unifrog brings into one place information about every undergraduate university course, apprenticeship, and college course in the UK. This makes it easy for students to compare and choose the best university courses, apprenticeships or further education courses for them, and to look for opportunities based upon their current postcode.

Additionally, the platform helps students successfully apply for these opportunities by writing their personal statement, applications and CVs and guiding them through the process, allowing teachers to give live feedback.

Students and teachers can also record careers-related activities on Unifrog, all of which are available for students to reflect upon and explore further opportunities for themselves. By completing their interests profile on Unifrog, students can be invited to any careers-related activities such as employer visits, trips and talks that fall within their specific interests and ambitions.

Students will receive a welcome email from Unifrog with instructions about how to login. Once set up, students then login using their email address and password and they can do so from any computer, tablet or smartphone.
