You have to be in some form of recognised study or training until your 18th birthday – you can do Apprenticeships and Traineeships, for example, but couldn't go straight into a full-time job.

You will have plenty of options to choose from when it comes to education, training or entering the world of work after you get your GCSE results.

- Vocational qualifications
 - o GCSEs don't have to lead to A Levels. You might find that vocational qualifications like BTECs and T-levels are a better option because they're a practical springboard into a career that involves hands-on learning.
- A Levels
 - o You can check with your several local sixth forms and colleges to find out what's involved in studying A Levels.
- Apprenticeships
 - o Apprenticeships are a way to combine earning a salary, building experience and learning to gain a qualification.
