

The table below outlines the French areas of study from Year 7 to Year 11:

Year group	Areas of study
Year 7	Introduction/revision, family and animals, personality and descriptions, where we live, school life, the present tense of ER verbs, daily routine, telling the time, places in town and directions, sports and hobbies, the future tense.
Year 8	Clothes, writing with detail in the present tense, the future tense with <i>aller</i> , invitations and making arrangements, food/drink and role plays, the past tense with <i>avoir</i> , using three tenses, GCSE photocard practice, film 'Le Petit Nicolas'.
Year 9, 10 and 11	Pupils will study a number of modules pertaining to the 3 themes of the GCSE course: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Theme 1: Identity and culture - Theme 2: Local, national, international and global areas of interest - Theme 3: Current and future study and employment.

Year 9	Personalised Learning Programme: Introductions and greetings, numbers, school life, the present tense of regular and irregular verbs, family and friends, physical and character descriptions, daily routine, where you live, reflexive verbs in the present tense, the near future tense, future plans, food and drink, the past tense.
