



Psychology Homework Guidance



Homework plays an important role in the delivery of GCSE Psychology and is used to support, extend and reinforce students' learning within the subject. Homework in Psychology will be set in accordance with the school's homework policy and students should expect to spend an hour a week completing the tasks set on SMHW.

A range of different tasks will be set, all with a different learning purpose.

- Pre-learning for up-coming topics.
- Retrieval of prior learning.
- Learning of new subject specific vocabulary.
- Practice for writing nine-mark evaluation questions.
- Revision for formal assessments.
- A02 questions, applying psychological knowledge to scenarios.
