In addition to these sessions, all subject teachers will be available in their classrooms during their normal timetabled lessons should students want a quiet place to work at any point during the day, or if they are staying in school between morning and afternoon exams. Some departments are also offering lunch revision sessions directly before afternoon exams.

Students who attend any session in school after 22 May will be required to report to the school office to register their attendance on site, and if the session is during the school day, they will need to be in uniform.
