I hope that you are well and that your child has made a successful start to their studies this year. In October 2023, the DfE published all schools' GCSE information for the previous year in their performance tables. Once again, Goldington has done exceptionally well! By clicking on "Start Now"/"All schools and Colleges in England", you will find Goldington Academy on the third page with a progress score of +0.88. This broadly relates to the fact that on average, in every subject, pupils at Goldington made almost a grade more progress than expected from the age of 11. We are in the top DfE category "Well above average" and the national position of 127th out of 6971 schools puts us in the top 2% of schools in the country!

All other indicators also looked excellent e.g. % of pupils obtaining a Grade 5 or above in English and maths/Attainment 8 score/average point scores obtained by pupils.

I do not normally write with detailed academic information, but I wanted to share these exceptional results with you. They really are a result of a huge amount of tremendous work by the whole staff, the pupils and the parents/guardians and carers at Goldington Academy. Thank you @teamgoldington!
