The Journey

Bedford – Dover

Dover – Calais 2 hours 30 minutes

Calais - Andorra
Approximately 12/15 hours driving
plus stops (2)

Arrive at Grandvalira, Andorra

The Journey

- Toilets on coach
- You may eat on the coach but not messy food!
- We will drive through the night after Calais this will be quiet, sleep time
- There will be two stops between Calais and Andorra – approx every 5/6 hours at services, you will need to have Euros with you for food
- You can bring phones/ipads etc. However, we accept no responsibility for loss/damage....

On Arrival

- Walk to the ski fitters to have boots, skis and helmets fitted
- A pair of ski socks will need to be included in hand luggage
- Walk ski equipment to Hotel for storage of equipment
- Inspect rooms and unpack
- Dinner

ADVANCED

- Have been on ski holidays
- Can ski on red and black runs
- Can parallel turn

A typical ski day

0700hrs: Wake up and get ready

0745hrs: Breakfast at hotel before walking to ski meeting point

• **1000hrs:** Ski lessons with local ski school (3 hours)

• **1230hrs:** Lunch

1400hrs: Begin afternoon ski instruction (2hrs)

1715hrs: Meet back at the Hotel

• **1900hrs:** Dinner

• **2000hrs:** Evening Activity

Weather

How cold is it in Andorra in February?

 Daytime temperatures usually reach 1°C in Andorra in February, falling to -7°C at night.

How sunny is it in Andorra in February?

 There are normally 5 hours of bright sunshine each day in Andorra in February - that's 45% of daylight hours.

What to pack for skiing

Provided for you:

- Skis
- Ski poles
- Helmet (legal requirement)

What to pack for skiing

- Waterproof ski jacket <u>travel in this!</u>
- Waterproof ski trouser
- Goggles
- Sunglasses (optional)
- Waterproof ski gloves or mittens
- 2/3 x Thermal tops and Thermal bottoms
- Warm hat/beanie/head band/balaclava
- Fleeces
- Neck warmer
- 3 x Ski socks
- Comfortable, waterproof shoes
- High factor sun cream and lip balm

Personal organisation

- We do not take spares!
- If you forget or lose something then you will be without it!
- Personal organisation makes a big difference on the trip to the smooth running of the day.
- Pupils need to be able to unpack ad pack away properly – unhelpful to be living out of a suitcase.
- We will be doing room checks!

- 0800hrs: Room inspections and check out of rooms / secure luggage storage is arranged with the hotel

- 1630hrs: Return equipment to rental shop
- 1700hrs: Freshen up after final ski lesson & load coach
- **1800hrs:** Dinner
- 1900hrs: Depart Resort

The journey home Friday 21st Feb - Sat 22nd Feb

- Travel overnight on Coach
- Breakfast on route (will need money for this)
- 1155hrs: Check in at Calais ferry port for 1325hrs P&O crossing to Dover
- 1325hrs: Ferry departs Dover for Calais
- Lunch on ferry (will need money for this)
- 1355hrs: Depart Dover
- 1730hrs: Arrive at Goldington Academy

Spending money

Whilst travelling-

- Ferry sterling
- Through France euros
- You need enough for refreshments/hot meal on the way

Whilst in Andorra

- Andorra is not a member of the EU but it does use the euro.
- We recommend no more than 100 euros which we will collect and Mr Atkinson will distribute in capacity of 'banker'. Money will be able to be withdrawn daily.
- Any money not used will be returned on arrival back at Goldington

Rules/Behaviour Expectations

- Behaviour expectations will be the same as we would expect in school
- Mobiles will be collected in nightly
