To celebrate World Book Day which is on Thursday, 6 March, we have organised a range of activities which will promote books and reading for pleasure.

Author Sue Wallman will be visiting the school on Friday, 28 February. She will be delivering a talk to all Year 7s and will be holding workshops with selected pupils from Year 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 on creative writing.

We will be running quizzes and competitions during library sessions to celebrate World Book Day. During these sessions, students will be given a World Book Day £1 token. These tokens can be used to buy any of the World Book Day £1 books or used to get £1 off a full price title. The tokens can be used at participating retailers such as independent book shops, Asda, Sainsburys, Tesco, The Works, Waterstones and WH Smith. They cannot be used for online purchases. There will also be a book swap event on Thursday, 6 March in the library.
